6. 2017-2018 USDA FOODS: INITIAL PINCO PURCHASE

Background: On February 2, 2017 CDE issued the USDA Foods Catalog for 2017-2018. With 26,049,250 Total Lunches Served (TLS) by the participating 39 PINCO Member Districts in 2015-2016, the Cooperative is scheduled to receive \$8,726,499.00 of USDA entitlement dollars (.335 per TLS) to use toward commodity food purchases; direct-delivery and diverted. On February 6, 2017, PINCO’s Commodity Sub-committee made up of Westside, Palmdale, Bakersfield City, Earlimart, AVHS, Wilsona and Kristi McKnight met to review:

- Catalog Offerings to PINCO and Processor
- Current inventories/scheduled loads in current year
- Usage at Processor in consideration of open RFP’s and Extensions
- Member District feedback/requests on USDA Foods for direct delivery and processor
- 2017-2018 Calendar to manage & stage entitlement and purchases throughout year.

Jackie Speidel reported out the recommended purchases for commodities for the upcoming year. See Attachment.

Motion by Bakersfield, Seconded by Panama-Buena Vista to approve the recommendation of the Commodities Committee. Motion Passed

7. WAREHOUSE: FORKLIFT REPLACEMENT

Background: One of PINCO’s five forklifts has reached the end of its effective life-cycle. The Hyster N40ER, purchased used in January, 1999 is currently out of service requiring PINCO to rent a forklift to handle daily loads (at \$375.00 per week). PINCO is in the process of receiving quotes to be discussed at today’s meeting. The Lead Agency recommends PINCO Advisory Committee to consider the purchase of a pre-owned replacement forklift with warranty for an amount not to exceed \$22,000.00 from the PINCO Marketing fund. The PINCO Marketing fund currently stands at \$36,989.00.

Motion by Panama-Buena Vista, Seconded by Lamont to approve the negotiation and purchase of a used forklift. Funds to come from the marketing fund and not to exceed \$22,000. Motion Passed

8. USDA PORK ROAST: DIVERSION OPTION FOR MEMBER DISTRICTS

Background: In receipt of requested USDA Pork Roast #100173 over the past month, PINCO initiated a Request For Quote for Pork Carnitas from “back-hauled” inventories. Based upon response, Rose and Shore has been awarded with this back-haul option and we look forward to Member Districts having this additional option to use their entitlement. PINCO will provide nutritional specs, pricing and ordering information to Member Districts over the next week.
