ACTION: REINSTATEMENT OF GREENFIELD UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT

Background: On September 27, 2017, the Greenfield Union School District Board of Education requested to withdraw from PINCO which was subsequently accepted by PINCO. Upon reconsideration and pending a scheduled meeting January 10, 2018, the Greenfield Union School District's Board of Education has/will request to rescind the prior action and to maintain membership in PINCO.

The Lead Agency recommends PINCO's Executive Committee accept Greenfield Union School District's request and forward to PINCO's Advisory Committee for approval at its January 18, 2018 meeting; new Membership requires an affirmative vote of a majority of the PINCO Advisory Committee per Section Eight of the PINCO J.P.A.. Subsequent to this action, the Lead Agency will forward this recommendation to the Antelope Valley Union High School District Board of Education for final ratification February 7, 2018.
