**3. PUBLIC COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR:**

Public Business from the Floor – Agendized Items and Non-Agendized Items: The public is invited to address items on the PINCO Agenda or any item that is within PINCO's jurisdiction as constituted. Without taking action or entering into a dialog with the public, PINCO Board members may briefly respond to statements made or ask clarifying questions about topics not on the PINCO agenda. Individual speakers are limited to three (3) minutes each with the total time for public input on each item limited to fifteen (15) minutes. All persons requesting to make comments are asked to complete a public speaking form prior to the meeting. You will be asked to provide your full name, who or what you are representing and the topic as an item identified on the agenda or as a non-Agendized item.

**4. ACTION: ADJUSTMENT IN FAIR MARKET VALUES REQUIRING CANCELLATION(S) IN 2020-2021 USDA FOODS SCHEDULE**

Background: On August 12, 2020, CDE informed PINCO that increases in fair market values with beef and cheese(s) scheduled for processing required PINCO to reduce its 2020-2021 USDA Foods schedule by \$1.4M. PINCO's Commodity Sub-committee met August 19, 2020 to discuss options in cancelling commodities in order to fall within its entitlement balance for the year. In consideration of PINCO's 2019-2020 processor carryovers, the proposed cancellations leave enough entitlement at processors to meet PINCO's needs throughout 2020-2021. CDE has given its pledge to assist PINCO in providing pounds through the state excess bank in the event PINCO requires more entitlement at processor(s) to meet Member District demand; CDE is forecasting a substantial increase in the state excess bank as a result of Agency's decreased usage of USDA Foods in 2019-2020 as a result of COVID.

It is recommended PINCO's Advisory Committee review the Sub-committee's proposed cancellations and direct the Lead Agency to adjust PINCO's 2020-2021 USDA Foods schedule as determined.
