5. APPROVAL: 2018-2019 USDA FOODS PURCHASE REQUEST
Background: With release of USDA's 2018-2019 Pre-planner, PINCO's Commodity Sub-committee met to develop recommendations present to PINCO's Executive and Advisory Committees for approval. The Sub-committee studied current & '16-'17 usage of directly and at-processor, inventory capacity and storage impact to develop its recommendations. Increased spending is seen in cannot commodities to off-set commercial purchases along with new fruit and vegetable options for processing and direct delivery. Greattention was given to diverting commodities to ensure ample inventories to work from while avoiding risk of high carry-over balance. The Members of Commodity Sub-committee represent a wide cross-section of Member Districts and did an outstanding job maximizing PINCO's 2018-2019 USDA entitlement and USDA Foods purchase. It is recommended PINCO's Executive Committee ratify and forwards using USDA spending recommendation to PINCO's Advisory Committee for approval.
